



Rules regarding the use of the ERF logo.

1. Permission can be granted to FULL members of the European Ranger Federation for the use of the ERF emblem/logo on letterheads, business cards or other promotional material/activities or for similar uses, provided written consent has been given by the ERF Executive Committee.
2. ERF Logo badges for use on clothing can be supplied to member associations on request.
3. All other requests for the use of the ERF logo should be made in writing to the ERF President (europe@internationalrangers.org).
4. The ERF brand must not be used in a manner that will cause misinformation about the Federation.
5. The ERF logo should only be used for matters that directly relate to Rangers and in accordance with the aims and objectives of the ERF.
6. The ERF logo must not be altered, modified or adapted but must be used in the original and unchanged form in which it is provided/downloaded.
7. The ERF logo cannot be used in a way to suggest an endorsement by the European Ranger Federation unless prior permission has been granted.
8. On letterheads (or other printed documents) the ERF logo must be used in conjunction with the member association's own logo or name. It should not be used alone or in any way that suggests that the letter or document is coming solely from the ERF.
9. The ERF logo should never be used in matters or communications relating to personal working policy or working conditions. The ERF is NOT a labour union.
10. In situations which might be regarded as making statements of a "political" or "lobbying" nature involving the ERF logo, members should seek approval in advance from the ERF Executive Committee via the ERF President - europe@internationalrangers.org
